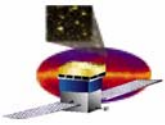
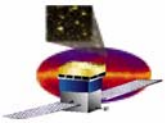

Accomplishments for August

- We made a lot of progress on the two GLAST Space Mysteries this month. They are now in internal review here at SSU. We expect a public release next month.
- Tim Graves started experimenting with building an image calibration plug-in for ImageJ (free imaging program). So far he has built a basic dark subtractor and a bias subtractor. The goal is to create a set of macros for this free program so that anyone can do calibrations and analysis of the GTN objects.
- The complete draft of the Spanish version of the Black Hole Fact Sheet is now being sent out for a final review. This will be printed in September.
- We also spent a large chunk of August recovering from the EA training.

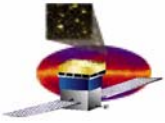


Accomplishments for August
