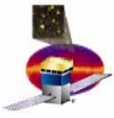
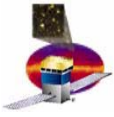

Accomplishments for Mar & Apr 2007

- The following products were approved by NASA product review from Fall 2006:
 - LAT simulator (on SLAC website) – recommended w/minor revisions
 - Magnetic Globe Lithograph – part of Supernova unit
- The following products need revisions and resubmissions:
 - Solar Supernova Space Mystery – science review only
 - Active Galaxy Pop-up book – already resubmitted for Spring 2007, awaiting final approval

- Both Sarah Silva and Phil Plait submitted resignations effective by June 1. Two new jobs have been posted. One new hire expected to begin in early June, second one is TBD
